

**IN THE MATTER OF
THE FAIR TRADING ACT**

THIS UNDERTAKING is made pursuant to Section 152 of the *Fair Trading Act*.

Brazolot Migration Group Inc.

in the City of Hudson, in the Province of Quebec,

(hereinafter called the "**Supplier**")

TO:

The **DIRECTOR OF FAIR TRADING,**

(hereinafter called the "**Director**")

WHEREAS:

- (A) The Supplier was a licensed employment agency in Alberta from May 3, 2011 to January 3, 2013.
- (B) The Supplier engaged in advertising for employees on behalf of employers in Alberta and other employment agency activities from the period of January 3, 2013 to January 2nd, 2014.
- (C) The Director asserts that he has reason to believe that the acts or practices of the Supplier described in recital (B) constitutes a breach of the licensing requirements of the *Fair Trading Act*.

NOW THEREFORE THIS UNDERTAKING WITNESSES THAT:

- 1. The Supplier acknowledges and admits that, by engaging in employment agency activities as described in recital (B), it failed to comply with the *Fair Trading Act* and undertakes to the Director that it will ensure that it is licensed appropriately going forward for any future employment agency activities.
- 2. The Supplier will ensure that it is in compliance with all regulatory requirements set out in the Employment Agency Business Licensing Regulation for any employment agency activity engaged in in Alberta.
- 6. This Undertaking will be binding upon the Supplier and its successors and assigns unless:
 - a. terminated by the Director or varied with the consent of the Supplier;
 - b. varied by an Order of the Judge of the Court of Queen's Bench where the Judge is satisfied that the circumstances warrant varying the provisions of the Undertaking;
 - c. terminated by an Order of a Judge of the Court of Queen's Bench where the Judge is satisfied that the act or practice that the Supplier has undertaken to refrain from engaging in was not unfair; however, in any such case, the termination or variance does not invalidate anything done under this Undertaking prior to termination or variance.
- 7. The Supplier acknowledges that the Director may, upon breach by the Supplier of any term of the Undertaking, institute such proceedings and take such action under the *Fair Trading Act* as he may consider necessary.

- 8. The Supplier acknowledges that this Undertaking is a public document and will be maintained in the public record by the Director of Fair Trading as required by s. 157.1 of the *Fair Trading Act*.
- 9. The Supplier acknowledges that it was advised by Service Alberta, and is aware that it is entitled to seek independent professional advice regarding the signing of this Undertaking, and the Supplier acknowledges that it is entering into this Undertaking voluntarily.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the Supplier has on this 7th day of April, 2014 agreed to the terms of this Undertaking.
